






#### **COACHES AND SUPPORT STAFF**



Matt Drakeley Head of Talent Pathway

Matt will be taking part in his sixth overseas tour with the Somerset Player Pathway this year, albeit with the Academy tour rather than the Pathway tour this year. As part of his role as Head of Talent Pathway at Somerset, Matt provides the strategy for the Somerset Player Pathway as well as delivering across various key age groups, the EPP and the Academy.

As a player, Matt, a wicketkeeper/batsman, represented Dorset at Minor County level and has played Premier League Cricket in both Somerset and Hampshire. In the winter of 2017, he became one of the youngest coaches to complete his ECB Master Coach Level 4 Award.

Matt's desire to add a diversity of opportunities to each player's Programme makes him very understanding of the positives of a trip overseas. "In the past these trips have been excellent to allow players to experience a wide range of different challenges. Players will not only be tested at times by the level of opposition but also by the heat, humidity, their ability to look after their bodies and the way pitches play."

Matt also knows the benefits these trips can have for players away from cricket. "It's important that the players give themselves a chance to look up and experience Sri Lanka as much as they can, it's a wonderful country that I'd encourage players to embrace as much as they can. The Sri Lankan people are some of the most hospitable I've ever met and the smiles on faces when we visit mean I look forward to going back every year."

Finally, Matt had one bit advice for players heading on tour in 2024 "Every year without fail we see players struggle on a match day to cope with the heat and the demands of the game in a tough climate, those who prepare well and make sure their fluid intake is maintained across a day's play will be those able to cope with the conditions best. Enjoy every moment both on and off the field".

Our focus has remained consistent; to support the network of clubs across Somerset with both developmental and playing opportunities, to inspire young people by accessing and experiencing cricket through schools, deliver vibrant and varied community programmes focusing on disability, mental health and wellbeing, working with underrepresented groups, whilst always striving to ensure the game is safer with a clear focus on

Safeguarding.



The Foundation is extremely fortunate to have a team of Development Staff that are both experienced and passionate in all our areas. Somerset is viewed as a Foundation that is well respected by our national partners, namely the ECB, Chance to Shine and the Lords Taverners, Becoming a trusted partner comes from consistency, reliability and strong delivery outcomes. We are also extremely fortunate to work with a number of local partners that support our vision.

There have been so many highlights throughout the year from across our programmes, too many to capture in this short overview, however a few that highlight our purpose:

Our Women's & Girls programmes continue to thrive. Five Girls hubs were established across the County for young female players to access free hardball coaching. This great initiative is supported by The Clowance Trust and has seen over 75 players accessing additional cricket. Furthermore. in the Women's game, the introduction of the Higos 100 - a women's competition that has brought a franchise theme to Somerset for the first time. Bespoke playing kit with a series of festivals across the County, with the Final being played at The Cooper Associates County Ground has been a huge success.



The growth of our wellbeing programmes has again seen significant growth. Together in Sport, in partnership with Reminiscence Learning has seen the development of a weekly dementia support aroup for individuals on their journey and carers. The group provides a safe space for carers to meet and talk and for others to get active with a variety for fun sporting activities. Walking Cricket is now in its second year, with six hubs across the County. The initiative caters for nearly 100 participants and has contributed to improved physical and mental wellbeing for older adults. A programme that brings people together through cricket has been Walkers & Talkers. This monthly event enables people to meet. visit the Somerset Cricket Museum, exercise through walking and listen to some wonderful quest speakers such as Vic Marks. Andv



Caddick, James Hildreth and many more.

The work across our diverse communities has been incredibly special and hugely rewarding this year. The Magbul project has supported displaced adults within both North Pertherton and Weston-super-Mare to take part in and engage with cricket across the county. With regular coaching, fixtures, an Eid celebration at CACG and the opportunity to watch a Vitality Blast T20 Blast fixture, the programme has been great at helping to integrate communities. A programme that has been a multi-agency approach with key local partners has set a great foundation for further work.

We have been incredibly fortunate to gain the support of a number of local, regional and national commercial partners. These partnerships have allowed us to



deliver more and further amplify opportunities for our communities. The collaborative and close relationship with Somerset County Cricket Club, is one of the best examples in the Country and we continue to work at both a strategic and operational level to ensure we maximise the opportunities that are presented.

We now look forward and plan for 2024. We will continue to ensure that our local cricket clubs sit at the top of our priority list, but we also strive to continue to enhance our reputation that provides a robust foundation for local partners to consider us a partner of choice to support our mutual outcomes and ambitions.


